לִישֵׁב בַּסֻּכָּה

Say this bracha every time you sit in the sukkah:

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ
הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו
וְצִוָּנוּ לִישֵׁב בַּסֻּכָּה.

Blessed are You, Hashem our God, King of the universe, who has made us holy through His commandments and commanded us to live in the sukkah.



שְׁהַחֲינוּ

*Say this bracha the first time you shake the lulav each year
and the first time you sit in the sukkah each year.*

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ
הָעוֹלָם שְׁהַחֲנוּ וְקִיָּמָנוּ
וְהַגִּיעָנוּ לְזֶמֶן הַזֶּה.

Blessed are You, Hashem our God, King of the universe, who has
kept us and sustained us, and enabled us to reach this time.



עַל נְטִילַת לוּלָב

Say this bracha before you shake the lulav each time.

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה יְיָ אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ
הָעוֹלָם אֲשֶׁר קִדְּשָׁנוּ בְּמִצְוֹתָיו
וְצִוָּנוּ עַל נְטִילַת לוּלָב.

Blessed are You, Hashem our God, King of the universe, who
has made us holy through His commandments and commanded
us to take up the lulav.



אֲשָׁפִיזִין

Each night in the sukkah we invite one of the Ushpizin. On the first night we invite Avraham, on the second night Yitzchak, and so on.
